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## IN-SERVICE TRAINING

Dmitri Mendeleev, was born on 8<sup>th</sup> February 1834, Tobolsk, Siberia, Russian Empire. He was a Russian chemist who developed the periodic classification of the elements. To mark his birth anniversary, the science department of Kids World School presented a ppt in a special online assembly.
