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## NEP COMPLIANCE

### PRE PRIMARY (Balvatika):

On the recommendation of NEP 2020 underlining the need of transforming the early childhood care and education in the country necessitated a fresh and comprehensive framework exclusively for this early stage. One of the important purposes of NCF for Foundational Stage 2022 is to formalize the education in foundational year i.e., 3 to 8 years age. The Board, in addition to its existing categories of affiliation, is expanding the affiliation of the existing affiliated schools offering foundational education to Balvatika (pre-school) classes, provided they fulfil all other requirements as mandated by CBSE. National Curriculum Framework for Foundational Stages 2022 is released Vide circular no. Aff.08/2023 dated 17.03.2023, the Board has adopted the NCF-FS 2022 and the new structure of five year education at the Foundational Stage (From Class Balvatika (Pre School) to Class II) will be introduced in the session 2023-24. The school has also started the implementation of the same in the school following the guidelines of NCF-FS

### **BAGLESS DAYS:**

The concept of **some bag less days in schools** is a fun-filled way of introducing vocational education right from the school level. The NEP 2020 proposes exposing at least 50% of learners to vocational education and vocational subjects. This is to attract the students and sensitise them to the workplace through engaging in activities involving the head, hand and heart. It will reduce the gap between bookish knowledge and the application of knowledge and expose children to skills in work areas helping them to decide on future career paths. Accordingly, the school had conducted many interesting bag less activities for the students of class I –X like carpentry, embroidery, Soap making, gardening, dinning etiquettes, nomenclature of plants inside the school premises, transforming waste to wealth etc.

## **HOLISTIC PROGRESS CARD**

Holistic Progress Card is a 360 degree, multidimensional report of progress, that reflects in detail the progress as well as the uniqueness of each learner in the cognitive, affective, socio-emotional, and psychomotor domains. It is a shift in assessment from one that is summative primarily testing rote memorization skills, to one that is more regular and formative - competency-based. It promotes learning and development for children, and evaluating higher-order skills, such as analysis, critical thinking, and conceptual clarity. The school has initiated the same in the school for all the classes from Nursery to class VIII for the session 2023-24. And had already prepared for kindergarten in the previous session.

## **USWAN EDUCONCLAVE:**

USWAN (Unaided Schools Welfare Association Nagpur) has organised EDU CONCLAVE 2023 scheduled on 30th June & 1st July 2023. Mrs. Neeru Kapai and Mrs. Mukta Chaterji were the resource persons to guide Implementation Strategies for Foundational stage, understanding Panchkosh & their relation with developmental domain's, teaching Strategy competency based education and Teaching learning material. Mrs. Arshiya Sheikh (Coordinator Preparatory stage) and Mrs. Yashika Yadav (Coordinator Foundational Stage) attended two days of workshop conducted in Modern School, Koradi Road.

## **FINANCIAL LITERACY AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AS SKILL SUBJECTS:**

Kids World School has started financial literacy as a skill subjects for classes VI, VII, VIII, IX and X. The objective of introducing Financial Literacy is to convey and make students understand the basic financial concepts, early methods of a transaction and the evolution of trade. It also covers the importance of collaboration through teamwork and focuses on the importance of a team. Students will be guided the origin of banking, the transition from coins to paper money, types of bank, major operations and services carried out by banks. The program provides information on Reserve Bank of India and also gives insight into the introduction of the digital payments, bank cards and the various benefits of these services. The students are made to understand the role of UIDAI and the importance of Aadhaar, and Aadhaar Enabled Payment System (AePS). It also enables the students to learn about the various forms of digital payments including internet banking, types of internet banking, mobile banking and mobile wallet.

**Annual CURRICULUM Planning:** Yearlong planning regarding pedagogical planning, Annual curriculum planning, and various registers to strengthen inclusive culture were also designed separately for all the activities. Improvement in certain pre-existing formats was made. Feedback and feed forward registers were reviewed and revised to understand and solve parents' query rose in PTMs. Different signage boards were designed and printed to sensitize the students and teachers for the expected behaviour in the school premise. All these activities were conducted during summer break.

### **ACHIEVEMENTS:**

1. **SPELL BEE:** National Spell Bee helps students to improve their spelling skills, word usage, sentence construction, pronunciation and ultimately over all use of language that will aid early years of growth and development and empower them with skills necessary for their future careers. From our school, Ms. Sweekriti Shahi from class X B secured 7<sup>th</sup> rank at the State Level Spell Bee along with 6 others who have secured various ranks ranging from 19<sup>th</sup> to 42<sup>nd</sup>
2. **Read N Grow:** Ms. Priyani Deshpande excelled in an inter school competition Read N Grow by clinching Consolation prize in group D. Akshaj Shahi was declared the school topper. Both the students were acknowledged by certificates and books as a token of their achievement.

### 3. **SOF Olympiads: Outstanding Achievements by Kids World School Students in Olympiads**

The SOF Olympiads are a great way to enrich the analytical and problem solving skills building confidence amongst the students. As always the school had put up a wonderful performance with 4 students qualifying for the level II of the IMO exam, one student each had qualified for the Level II of the NSO & IEO exam. In the ISSO (International Social Science Olympiad) conducted by SOF one of the student from the school Hiba Khan from class V has secured international rank 79, Regional rank 70 and zonal rank 68. Sweekriti Shahi has been awarded certificate of excellence as recognition for securing zonal ranking 18 for the Maharashtra and Goa zone. Apart from this Tarun Rathod from class IV and Aafiya Nawarangabade of class IX have been awarded with certificate of excellence at the Zonal Level.

Students from Kids World School have performed very well at the school level of the various Olympiads organized by the Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF) - **In the IGKO (International GK Olympiad)** the school students have received **1 Gold Medal of distinction** by Vinit Mote **from class II** and **2 gold medal of excellence** by

Jahra Anjum & Nivedita Rai **from class IV**. **In the IMO exam 2 students from class I secured gold medal of excellence-** Ibrahim Hasan & Syed Zainulabedin. **From class II 3 students have secured the gold medal of excellence-** Vinit Mote, Divya kupale & Divyanshi Ahir. **From class III, class IV and class V 1 student each secured the gold medal of excellence. 3 students from class VI have received the gold medal of excellence** - Divyansh Tale, Vedant Bhusari & Nabiha Akbani **who has also qualified for the II level of the examination**. From class VII & class IX Ali one student each has secured the Gold medal of excellence. **In the NSO exam** Vanshika Badnag from **class V** & Alina Galakatu **from class IX** have received the Gold medal of excellence.

Highlights of the Session:

The Resource persons for the event were Mrs. Neeru Kapai, Founder Principal Modern School & Dr. Rakesh Ranjan, Principal Podar International School, Ballarpur. Our 33 teachers were trained for the same.

### **4. CBSE CBP on National Education Policy 2020 by CoE Pune.**

Our Director, Principal and teachers are continuously attending the online trainings conducted by CIET and upgrading their skills and knowledge.

## **In- House Training**

**9. Health & Wellness (16<sup>th</sup> June and 17<sup>th</sup> June 2023):** Two days of in-house training was conducted on the theme Health and Wellness in school. Around 50 teachers were trained on the topic consisting of 11 modules. The resource persons were Mrs. Jayati A. Vasudeo (Director of Kids World School) and Ms. Kirti Sharma ( Senior Coordinator of Kids world School).

We at Kids World School believe that schools play a vital role in helping students establish lifelong healthy behaviours. Recognizing the importance of this, school based health promotion activities have been incorporated for the session 2023-24 as a part of the Health and Wellness component of the Ayushman Bharat Program. Age appropriate, interesting, joyful interactive activities for one hour have been included in students' timetable.

**10. Oxford Advantage (20th June and 21<sup>st</sup> June 2023):** An orientation program by Oxford publication was held for the teachers of Nursery to class VIII on the usage of the various resources offered by Oxford for the betterment of the teaching-learning process. The teachers were give a hands on experience of the same by the resource person.

**11. Soft Skill and Communication (22<sup>nd</sup> June 2023) :** To enhance communication skill, promote team work, developing inter personal management and analysing critical thinking, one hour workshop was conducted by Mr. Diparatna Kurvey on 22nd june 2023. 48 teachers attended the same.

## **EXAMINATION**

**1. PRELIMS:** Prelims are important from studies point of view they are pivotal and to mentally prepare a child for the Board exams. If you are a good student who has studied well throughout the year they are like practice matches, you get the feel of what will happen in the exams, you get the feel of the exam. There were three class X prelims conducted for the academic session 2021-22 which were held one in the month of December and two in the month of Feb'2023 before the commencement of the board exam.

**2. FLN:** As per the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the highest priority for the school education system is to achieve universal acquisition of foundational literacy and numeracy skills at primary level by 2025. Foundational learning is the basis of all future learning for a child. Not achieving basic foundational skills of being able to read with comprehension, writing and doing basic mathematics operations, leaves the child unprepared for the complexities of the curriculum beyond grade III. Under this, major initiatives have been undertaken under NIPUN Bharat Mission like: Creation of DIKSHA FLN portal for availability of FLN resource, Launch of NISHTHA-FLN for teachers of preschool to Grade V...etc. All teachers are encouraged for the same.

**3. IN HOUSE OLYMPIAD:** In order to provide exposure to competitive skills, all the students of class I & II were subjected to an in-house Olympiad for Maths and English subject in the school. These Olympiad were MCQ based and of 25 marks, designed by the expert subject teachers. The winners of these Olympiads were felicitated by providing them with a book for knowledge enhancement.

**4. GREEN OLYMPIAD:** It is an environment-based examination for students from classes 4 – 12 to enhance knowledge and skills amongst students on environment and sustainability issues.

GREEN Olympiad is supported by the Ministry of Education, and Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. All participants will be receiving certificates. Prizes and incentives for top performers.

**5. VVM: Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan (VVM):** is an initiative of Vijnana Bharati (VIBHA), in collaboration with National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) for students of class VI to IX. This year 28 students have participated in the exam from the school.

### MISCELLANEOUS

**1. Visit to Indian Science Conference:** 108th Indian Science Congress was held from January 3 -7- 2023 at R.T.M. Nagpur University, Nagpur. The theme of the exhibition was Science and Technology for sustainable development with inclusive involvement of all sections of society including women. Students from classes IV to IX visited the mega expo. The aim of organizing this trip was to engage and motivate students in authentic science experiences essentially the work of experts. Happy faces returned back with full of information and scientific temperament.

**2. Movable Planetarium in the School:** An out of box information on Astronomy under a movable dome Planetarium in association with PugMarg Planet Play was organized for the students from class I to Class X on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> January 2023. Students got wonderful exposure of 360 degrees on different astronomical ideas.

### **3. JSW and Jindal Vidya Mandir**

JSW foundation and Jindal Vidya Mandir in collaboration with Nehru Science Centre, Mumbai and Raman Science Centre, Nagpur held biennial JSW Science Conclave in kalmeshwar on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> January 2023. The theme of the exhibition was Sustainable Development Goals. Akshaj Shahi participated in category A (Class Vi to VIII) and prepared a model on Road Water Harvesting. Mohd. Ashar Khan made a

Blind stick for people having low or no vision. Both the models were appreciated and Blind stick was the attraction among judges and viewers. These students were acknowledged with individual trophies and certificates. Akshaj and Ashar worked under the guidance of Mrs. Qamrunnisa Khan.

3. **HEALTH CHECKUP:** Amid rising concerns over students' health in schools, the NMC began a campaign called JAGRUK PALAK- SUDRUDH BALAK (Alert Parents-Healthy Children), to monitor the health of kids through Check – Ups. We at our school had conducted a physical exam of students from classes KG I to class V on 08<sup>th</sup> March 2023 and classes VI to X on 09<sup>th</sup> March 2023, by the physician Dr. Shahbaaz Qureshi & Senior Nurse Ms. Upasna Naitam from NMC. Children of **migrant** labour were sensitized towards the importance of quality education through a video. Ms. Kirti Sharma, senior coordinator, encouraged the children that regular attendance to school is very important



to fight against child labour. All these children were gifted new books, pencil and sweet. Happy children moved with a smile accompanied by zeal to study hard to set new goals.

**4. Transportation Committee Meeting (14th July 2023):** Mr. Ravindra katolkar , Education Officer conducted a meeting at Deshpande hall to sensitize the schools in Nagpur to understand the responsibility owing to transportation. The meeting was conducted in presence of The Police Commissioner. Our principal Mrs. Swapna Nair and Manager Mrs. Rupa Sharma attended the meeting.

#### **10. Picnic/Excursion: Class III – X Picnic to “The Tiger Paradise Resort and Water Park”**
