DAY	NAME OF THE ACTIVITY	ACTIVITY DETAILS	LEARNING OUTCOME
DAY 1	Spelling Bee	Participants take turns spelling increasingly difficult words aloud. Eliminations occur on incorrect spelling, and the last remaining student is the winner.	Develops accurate spelling and pronunciation. Builds confidence and public speaking skills. Increases word recall and memory.
DAY 2	Word chain	Students form a chain of words where each word begins with the last letter of the previous word. The game can be played with a theme (e.g., nouns, verbs, adjectives).	Enhances quick thinking and vocabulary recall. Encourages active participation and listening. Strengthens understanding of parts of speech and word categories.
DAY 3	Picture Prompt Storytelling	Students are shown an image (or a series of images) and asked to create and narrate a short story inspired by it. They can either write it first or speak directly in front of the class in turns.	Enhances imagination and creative thinking. Improves verbal and written expression. Boosts narrative structure understanding (beginning, middle, end). Develops public speaking and listening skills.
DAY 4	Character Dress-up Day	Students come dressed as their favorite storybook character and speak a few lines or a monologue as the character. Props and small performances can be included.	Deepens understanding of character traits, settings, and stories. Encourages empathy and role-play. Enhances dramatic and presentation skills. Fosters creativity and a love for reading.
