DAY	NAME OF THE ACTIVITY	ACTIVITY DETAILS	LEARNING OUTCOME
DAY 1	Literary Quiz / Riddle Time	A fun quiz session based on storybooks, famous authors, idioms, poems, and literary terms. Riddle Time involves solving language-based riddles individually or in teams.	Encourages critical thinking and quick recall. Improves comprehension of literary elements and vocabulary. Builds teamwork and healthy competition. Reinforces knowledge in a playful format.
DAY 2	Special Event Idea: “Author’s Chair” or “Read Aloud Day”	Each student comes prepared to read aloud a short poem, story, or their own writing from the “Author’s Chair.” It creates a platform for expression and appreciation of literature.	Boosts confidence in reading aloud and presentation. Encourages original writing and appreciation of peer work. Develops listening, empathy, and constructive feedback skills. Cultivates respect for diverse literary voices.
DAY 3	Picture Prompt Storytelling	Students are shown an image (or a series of images) and asked to create and narrate a short story inspired by it. They can either write it first or speak directly in front of the class in turns.	Enhances imagination and creative thinking. Improves verbal and written expression. Boosts narrative structure understanding (beginning, middle, end). Develops public speaking and listening skills.
DAY 4	Character Dress-up Day	Students come dressed as their favorite storybook character and speak a few lines or a monologue as the character. Props and small performances can be included.	Deepens understanding of character traits, settings, and stories. Encourages empathy and role-play. Enhances dramatic and presentation skills. Fosters creativity and a love for reading.
